This interesting piece was found in a drawer at a plastics company. The plastic was poured into the design, when it was still wet the gold glitter, shells and pearls were laid on it, and dried in place. The piece is very flexible. It was sewn down to a silk mat, lifting the top mat up a little created a space for

loose glitter to fall into and disappear. Some of the larger glitter pieces were glued to the silk mat, continuing the sparkle! The frame is imitation stingray with a cart gold lip!
