After many years, she graduated! The announcement was separated and float mounted over the backing fabric. The Honor Medallion ribbon was left whole and tucked into the back of the framing package. The school logo and lines were etched into the glass, giving a very personal touch to the complete framing package!

As a young girl she would have practiced her stitching on any material that was available!

The dishrag was sewn down to the green linen. Light colored linen was used on the scoop. A burl wood frame and fillet were used to give it an antiqued look.

This scarf had been in the box for years and was a pleasant surprise when the client rediscovered it!

The scarf was ironed and pin stretched to an acid freeboard. Spacers were used to raise the museum glass off the scarf. A gold frame with compo detailing in the corners created a beautiful piece of art for the wall, not just the drawer!
